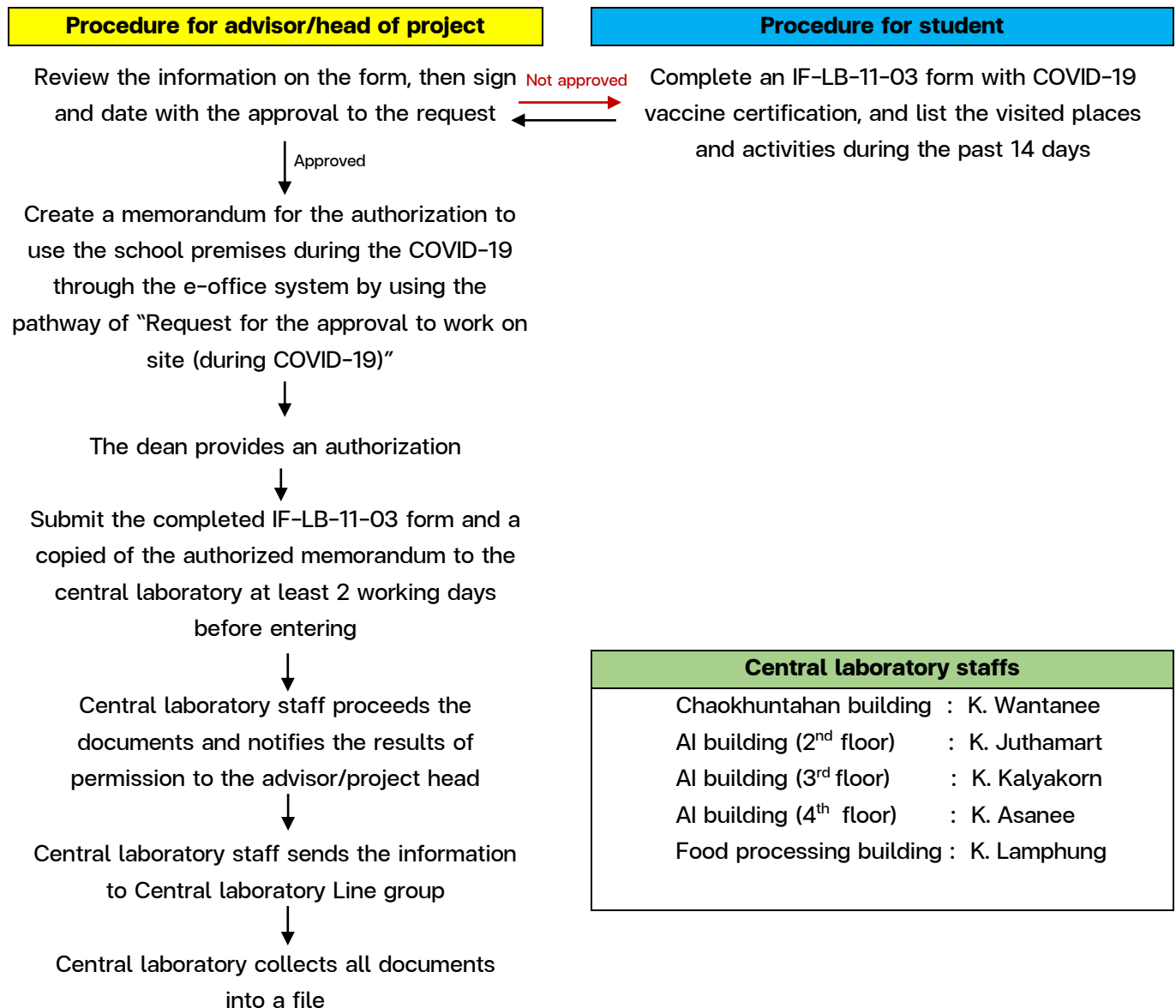


**Procedures for requesting the use of School of Food Industry's laboratory space and premises under the announcements on the measures to prevent and control the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)**

According to the announcements on the measures to prevent and control the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (No.30), School of Food Industry has announced the regulation and guidelines for laboratory work and the use of building spaces during the COVID-19 outbreak for students. After October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, **undergraduate students who are expecting to graduate in academic year 2021 and graduate students** are permitted to enter the building and use the laboratory spaces only for conducting the laboratory works necessarily to the research study. Only 2 students are permitted for each laboratory room. To comply with the safety measures to prevent and control the outbreak of the COVID-19, the central laboratory has announced the procedures for requesting the authorization to use the laboratory spaces and faculty premises, as shown below.



**Note**

1. Undergraduate students are able to use the laboratory spaces only on weekdays (Monday-Friday) from 8.30 to 16.30, except national holidays.
2. Graduate students who have classes on weekend are able to use the laboratory only on Saturday and Sunday from 9.00 to 16.00.
3. All students must be authorized from the school website before making a requisition to use the laboratory equipment.
4. Research advisor and head of project must collect all documents regarding a vaccine certification and a list of places visited and activities of the students during the past 14 days.

All students, researchers, research assistants, faculty members and staffs must follow the general safety practices when using the laboratory spaces as follows:

- Wear a facemask or cloth mask at all times during the laboratory operation (Mask must have well-fitting a nose-bridge).
- Strictly maintain physical distancing of at least one arm length.
